6:30pm, Thursday, January 8

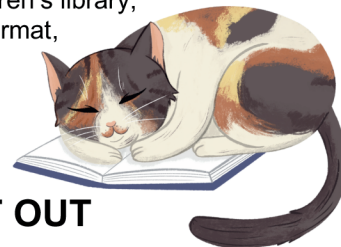
Read a new STEAM themed book each month, then get together to experiment! Practice collaboration and communication skills as you work on fun challenges. For kids in grades 1 & 2.
