

Welcome to the Fourth Annual Library Garden Tour. Over the past 4 years, the Garden Tour has blossomed into an eagerly awaited community event. All funds raised from the tours have been added to the library building fund.

A capital campaign to raise \$700,000 towards the cost of construction began in January. To date, more than 500 donors have pledged \$500,000 to the campaign. This program book lists donors at the \$100 level and above. The library appreciates this support but there is still a great need for help. If you have not yet made your pledge, we urge you to do so soon. If fund raising is successful, the project could go out to bid later this year.

The Library thanks the six gardeners who worked to make their gardens beautiful. The end result makes it look easy; but we know it wasn't. We also thank British Airways for donating two airline tickets to London. Refreshments were donated by Giant Eagle, Sorbara's Shop and Save and McDonalds. Balloons marking each garden were provided by The Balloon Company.

## Garden Descriptions

### 380 Avon Drive

"Shade" is the theme of this Master Gardener's yard. Ground covers include pachysandra, sweet woodruff and hedera helix. Other plants include ferns, columbine, forget-me-nots, digitalis, and a deep violet rhododendron.

### 811 Rockwood Avenue

This cottage garden showcases ivy, rhododendron, azaleas, boxwood, peonies, foxglove, hollyhock and lilies. A wooden trellis covered with old-fashioned roses, a diamond shaped herb garden and an armillary sphere--an instrument used by early astronomers-- are featured in this memorable garden.

### 185 Crestvue Manor Drive

This garden on a lovely cul-de-sac is a wonderland of trees. Japanese maple, gingko, and Montgomery Spruce mingle with holly azaleas, pachysandra and blue junipers. Birch trees form an archway to a rear garden of firs and berry shrubs.

### 124 Longuevue Drive

Peonies, daylilies, dahlias, mums, lace hydrangeas and other flowers are highlights of this garden. Also on the tour is the "knitting room" complete with houseplants, waterfall and goldfish pond.

### 441 Neulon Drive

This garden features a hillside garden with waterfall and pond, surrounded by heather, shrubbery, magnolia trees and a terraced bed of annuals and perennials.

### 236 Parker Drive

This profuse garden features chestnut, dogwood, lilacs, everblooming magnolia. Also thriving are climbing roses, vegetable and herb gardens and flower beds of bleeding hearts, poppies, annuals, ivy and roses.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE GARDENS

**#1 - 380 AVON DRIVE** - From Library, turn right onto Castle Shannon Blvd., then right at first intersection onto Hemlock. At 2nd stop sign, turn left onto Jefferson Drive. At next stop sign, bear left at the traffic island onto Avon Drive. Garden is the 4th house on right.

**#2 - 811 ROCKWOOD AVENUE** - From Garden on Avon go 2 houses to stop sign. Turn right onto Brucewood and continue down the hill to Mt. Lebanon Boulevard. Make a quick left onto Hoodridge (by Thrift Drug). Continue up the hill and turn left at second intersection onto Rockwood. Garden is on right at beginning of third block.

**#3 - 185 CRESTVUE MANOR DRIVE** - Go back up Rockwood to Hoodridge. Turn left and continue past 2 stop signs to intersection with Terrace Drive. Turn right onto Terrace, then right onto Rte. 19 (Washington Road). At 3rd traffic light, turn right onto Crestvue Manor Drive. Garden is at the end of the cul-de-sac.


**#4 - 124 LONGUEVUE DRIVE** - Return to light at Rte 19. Longuevue is directly across the intersection to the left of the traffic island. Garden is on the right, midway down the street. Longuevue runs into Woodhaven which loops around and comes back to Rte. 19.

**#5 - 441 NEULON DRIVE** - Return to Rte 19 and turn left. Continue to Cochran Road (2nd traffic light). Turn left onto Cochran Road and continue 1.1 miles (6 traffic lights) to Parker Drive. Turn right onto Parker and bear left at the traffic island onto Midway. At first intersection turn right at blue bus stop sign. Garden is immediately on left.

**#6 - 236 PARKER DRIVE** - From house on Neulon, go straight ahead onto Parker Drive and turn left. Continue along Parker to 2nd stop sign (at intersection of N. Meadowcroft). Garden is 3rd house on left past intersection.

**#7 LIBRARY- SILENT AUCTION** - Continue on Parker to stop sign. Turn right on Beverly Road. Take Beverly to light at Cochran and turn left. Take Cochran to intersection with Rte. 19 and turn left. Turn right at 2nd traffic light.
