OPEN WHILE CLOSED: ADULTS

2020 was Mt. Lebanon Public Library's most challenging year as administrators, staff, and the board grappled with the question of, "How can a library continue to serve its community when it has been mandated to close its doors?"

In January, February, and early March it was business as usual at the library with a full calendar of live programs and meetings. The library buzzed with patrons who were using the computers, browsing, studying, attending programs, shopping at the Book Cellar, and meeting tutors or friends. The Annual Brews for a Chili Night on January 25 welcomed a sold-out crowd (350), planning for the annual July Garden Tour had begun, and the first in what was to be a series of "Global Beats"-- after-hours, cultural get-togethers--had been held on March 6.

Then on March 13 everything came to a screeching halt as staff mobilized to shutter the library. The library's last day of regular service was Saturday, March 14, and patrons flooded the building in an effort to stock up on books and videos--8,500 items circulated on that day (8.5 times the amount circulated on a "normal" day). By the end of the month, however, numerous virtual programs were popping up on our calendar and Zoom had become our new best friend. These classes and programs included already planned live events that staff morphed into virtual ones, including our Speaker Series, arts and crafts programming, wellness classes, board game nights, storytimes, special presentations for all ages, career counseling, job skill programs, book discussions, and STEAM programs. New series and classes--including music, special storytimes, Great Courses discussion, a movie group, an Instagram teen book group, book discussions, and even a class focusing on dealing with anxiety and stress during a pandemic--were scheduled as well. Additional e-resources were added and the library's website was redesigned to emphasize the new virtual content. Since our patrons could no longer come in to browse, we purchased software to create electronic book lists that linked titles to our digital collections or our physical collections when available. While closed, we were able to continue reference services by email and phone. We kept in touch with our group leaders, many of whom reported that they had set up their own virtual meetings. In addition, library staff created all-ages events around themes such as HallowEEK! (a virtual Fright Night week) and Home for the Holidays and were able to sustain a virtual summer reading club and introduce a Winter Reading Club for all ages. Our annual Love Your Library Month, Garden Tour, and beer tasting fundraisers went virtual and we added the new Stay Home and Read Gala. When able to expand our services, we reconfigured the library and staff offices to allow for social distancing, instituted a contact-free pickup service, and made browsing and computers available by appointment.

We eagerly look forward to the day when we get back to "normal," but the success of these virtual programs and services means many will remain on our roster as just another way the library serves its community. We are proud to have met--and bested--the COVID challenge.

SOCIAL MEDIA & E-NEWS

Mt. Lebanon Public Library already had a robust social media presence when the pandemic started, but with life in a constant state of flux, our social media, e-newsletters and e-blasts became an important way to get information out to the public quickly. Patrons turned to social media as well to keep up-to-date: Facebook followers increased 10 percent in 2020; Instagram followers jumped to 1,171; and our many e-newsletters and e-blasts go out to 5,182 subscribers.

To help our patrons stay connected, we created the "Mt Lebanon Library Alone-Together" Facebook Group on April 3. During the quarantine, people used the page to share photos of projects they were doing, discuss books, and ask/answer questions on a myriad of topics. Membership grew quickly; there were 348 members at year's end. We plan to turn that group into a Book Discussion Group once the library's pre-COVID services resume. In addition, we added a Facebook "Question of the Week" to keep people engaged. All questions pertain to books. The questions are often the most popular posts of the week.

OPEN WHILE CLOSED: CHILDREN'S



Immediately after the shutdown order, the Children's Department staff took crash courses in video editing to get storytimes and bookclubs online quickly. The switch was deemed a success as clubs fill monthly. The popular Peeps Diorama Contest, which was already in progress, was shifted to a virtual event by extending the deadline, allowing photo submissions, and online voting. Kindergarten Readiness programs became short Zoom video series called "Kindergarten Tip Time." Even the annual mock Caldecott program became virtual as librarians recorded themselves reading the books then sent the videos to the elementary schools and invited the public to view and vote on their favorite book. Zoom was used to make programs and workshops—both those already planned and new ones—virtual. Librarians appeared in so many videos, they are now getting recognized in public—meaning we had definite engagement from patrons who were unable to visit us physically.

An all-ages, thrice-weekly video-storytime ("Morning Stories") was instituted over the summer to provide that core storytime service while most of the children's staff was furloughed. The weekly Crafternoon program morphed into a live Zoom program with preassembled take-home kits that patrons could pick up in advance through contactless service. Readers' advisory newsletters and video book talks appeared throughout the summer.

Using Beanstack, a software to manage and measure reading challenges, meant COVID couldn't stop the summer reading program, with every kid or teen who finished receiving a gift card to a local bookstore. New programs created in 2002 include a Halloween-themed obstacle course (Pumpkin Path) outside the library; this was hugely popular and made our patrons very happy. A new Book Bundle service—books on a specific topic gathered and bagged by the librarians—also has been a great success.

When full staffing resumed, social distancing in the Children's Department's small office space proved tough, so staff staggered shifts. When the library began welcoming patrons again, children received stickers instead of the stamps they got in pre-COVID days, to avoid close contact and hand touching. "It's a small kind gesture that means a lot to kids who have lost their routine," says one librarian.

GRANTS & AWARDS

We are grateful to the Kathryn DiNardo Foundation for their support of Mt. Lebanon Public Library's Speaker Series. Their generous grant, received in 2020, will allow the Speaker Series to continue to offer inspiring and informative Speaker Series events moving forward.

We also wish to thank Matt's Maker Space for their ongoing support of our STEM Programs, the Jack Buncher Foundation for their tremendous generosity in supporting the county-wide Love Your Library fundraising campaign, and Waste Management Inc. for their support of our Teen Sound Studio programming with their generous contribution to Mt. Lebanon Public Library made via the State of Pennsylvania's EITC program.



FACILITY UPGRADES

We opened our new Learning Lab in January and until mid March, the space served as the venue for Fiber and Fine Arts programs, daily Teen Times, various administrative meetings, and activities during our Matt's Maker Space Year of Making Kickoff. We also held several computer classes and career development programs in February and March. We will resume these and other programs in the space when we begin in-person classes again (TBA).

We were able to take advantage of the building being closed to complete much needed improvements around the library, including a new HVAC system, upgrades to the main staircase, and other small projects.

PARTNERSHIPS

One reason the library was able to pivot to virtual programming so quickly and seamlessly was thanks to our many community partnerships. These organizations allowed us to offer classes, workshops, and events on a multitude of topics to patrons of all ages. In 2020, Matt's Maker Space funded a third Year of Making at the library (19 programs with 305 children participating). We also continued our partnerships with, among others, the Career Development Center at the JFCS Pittsburgh, Family Hospice, Himalayan Institute, Veterans Breakfast Club, the Alzheimer's Association, League of Women Voters, Literacy Pittsburgh, the Pittsburgh Children's Museum, the Heinz History Center, Mt. Lebanon Nature Conservancy, the Audubon Society of Western PA, and the Historical Society of Mount Lebanon.



SEE OUR GARDENS GROW

The one thing that COVID-19 couldn't stop was our amazing volunteer gardeners. Being outside, wearing masks, and staying in separate areas of the gardens while working, they were able to keep the library grounds looking amazing all year. Work they accomplished in 2020 includes:

- Planting spring bulbs, the vegetable garden (13 types of plants and herbs—from tomatoes and hot peppers to bok choy and Glacier Rose shallot), and 12 new plant varieties around the library (wild petunia and catmint to peacock orchid and Christmas ferns).
- Transplanting shrubs, weeding, trimming, pruning, and watering
- Maintaining the compost pile and pond (alas, no fish this year)
- Updating the Library Garden Booklet and installing plant markers to identify shrubs, trees, perennials, annuals, and bulbs
- Dealing with a groundhog

Municipal crews fixed a leaking watering system, installed a water spigot for the gardener's convenience, mulched the flower beds, and planted annuals in the plot on Castle Shannon Blvd, including red cannas, *Verbenia Bonariensis*, red border roses, and summer blooming hydrangeas.

In all, 18 garden volunteers worked 1,000+ hours.

FRIENDS OF MT LEBANON LIBRARY

2020 was a year of change and challenge for the Friends of the Mt Lebanon Public Library. January, February, and early March were business as usual with the Book Cellar used book store open and bringing in \$12,440. The Brews for a Chili Night at the end of January, chaired by Bob Hagerty and M.A. Jackson, brought in another \$7,500.

But then came COVID. After months of no income, we brainstormed ideas to serve the public and raise funds safely and in a contact-free manner. The result? Two (September 27 & October 3) Drive-by Grab Bag Book Sales where books were packed in bags by genre, with five books per bag. Shoppers would pull up to the Library, select a genre from a menu, and a volunteer took their payment (\$10 per bag) and put the bag(s) in the trunk of their car. The sales brought in \$2,160.

We studied what other libraries were doing and "stole" the idea for a Shopify Online Bookstore from the Hawaii Public Library system. Volunteer coordinator Mandy Mitchell set up and manages the Shopify store while coordinator Susan Bloom handles the book listings and descriptions. We opened on November 5 for Book Cellar volunteers only, and then to the general public two weeks later. We package orders and buyers pick them up at the library. Our gross for November and December was \$5,461. The online store is at *mt-lebanon-bookcellar.myshopify.com*. We have 700+ books listed and urge people to check back often as we have a lot of turnover.

Our popular summer Brew for a Chili Night event went virtual, raising \$1,193 in donations with 62 attendees. Since we could not hold our winter 2021 beer tasting event, in December (when tickets would have gone on sale) we issued a chili cookbook, compiled by M.A. Jackson, using recipes from past Brews for a Chili Night events. These cookbooks are available on our Shopify Store for \$10. To date, we have sold about 70 books.

Mt. Lebanon Public Library has always had a remarkable level of support from volunteers. Few, if any, however, have matched the dedication of David McKibben, who died Jan. 11, 2021, of complications from heart surgery at age 78.

Over the past 15 years, David has been an almost daily presence at the library, where his volunteer hours exceeded 600 annually. Although most of those hours were spent at the Book Cellar used book store, he also served as president of the Friends of the Mt. Lebanon Public Library, which oversees fundraising projects and allocates money for library causes. He was one of the lead organizers of the library's annual garden tour and often introduced speakers at library events. In 2019, he was honored with Mt. Lebanon's Community Service Award.



SPEAKER SERIES









Above: We have been quarantining all returns and incoming holds in Meeting Room A for 96 hours before processing them.



On March 7, 2020--one week before the quarantine began--we hosted the first in what was intended to be a series of Global Beat all-ages, community get-togethers with music and food.


