




Download and stream free videos, music, audiobooks, e-books and comics on your mobile device or computer.

Create an Account:

1. Go to mtlebanonlibrary.org, click **Digital Media**, then one of the following: **eBooks**, **Digital Audiobooks**, **Online Music** or **Video on Demand** and then click on the **Hoopla** link. On the Hoopla main page, click the **Get Started Today** button to create an account.
2. Enter the required information using your email address and password. Each field must be typed twice for verification purposes. Click **Next** in the bottom right hand corner of the page.
3. Select **Mt. Lebanon Library** from the **Choose a Library** drop down menu. Click **Next**.
4. Enter your full library card number without spaces. Click **Next**.
5. You should now see a “Welcome to Hoopla” page. Please note, you’re allowed to borrow up to 10 titles from Hoopla a month. You can also access your Hoopla content by installing their free app, available on the Apple/Android App Store, on your mobile device.

Browse and Borrow Content:

1. From within the Hoopla site, click **Browse** to see a variety of available titles. You can also choose between, **Audiobooks**, **Movies**, **Music**, **Comics**, **eBooks**, and **Television** in the drop-down menu.
2. Within a selected category you may browse by the following lists: **recommended**, **featured**, **popular**, and **categories**.
3. You can also click **Search** at the top of the page to search by a specific title, author, or keyword.
4. To borrow a title, click the blue **Borrow** button. To get more information on a title beforehand, click on the cover art first. Please note, loan periods and the ability to stream or download may differ depending on the title.
5. After you have borrowed a title you can either play it by streaming or download it to your mobile device. Streaming requires an active Internet connection. Downloads are stored on your device do not require an active Internet connection.
6. Click on **My Hoopla** in the upper left-hand side of the page to access everything checked out to your account.
7. Please note, borrowed items will be automatically returned after the lending period is over.
