



# READ 1000 BOOKS before kindergarten



All it takes is sharing one book a day with your child to build a foundation for lifelong success.

Children who have not yet started Kindergarten are eligible to participate in the 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten program.

- 1 | Stop by the library to sign up and get your folder.
- 2 | Count your books using the provided paper logs to track your child's progress.
- 3 | After each 100 book milestone, visit the library to receive your special sticker.
- 4 | When your child reaches 1,000 books read, stop into the library and get a diploma and a reward! Your child may also pose for a picture with the 1,000 books milestone sign.

**FAQs:**

How do we read 1,000 books before Kindergarten?

1 book per day for 3 years = 1,095

10 books per week for 2 years = 1,040

3 books a day for 1 year = 1,095

Do we have to read only books from the library?

No! Any book counts. Now matter where you get them from or how many times you read them - they all count.

I have more than one child to read to, can I count the same title for each child?  
Yes!
